The San Francisco State Scholars program provides undergraduate students with an accelerated pathway to a graduate degree. Students in this program pursue a bachelor's and master's degree simultaneously. This program allows students to earn graduate credit while in their junior and/or senior year, reducing the number of semesters required for completion of a master's degree.

This roadmap is a suggested plan of study and does not replace meeting with an advisor. Please note that students may need to adjust the actual sequence of courses based on course availability.  - <u>Students may only apply up</u> to <u>4 units</u> for <u>each course</u> in the <u>major</u>, though some courses are repeatable for credit toward electives.
 - All upper-division COMM courses between COMM 400-599 may be used as electives only if their corresponding area above is already met with other courses. For example, if a student has completed 8 units of Rhetoric and Performance, they may take additional

- <u>units in Rhetoric and Performance to apply towards the electives</u> requirement.
- Only 2 units from a lower-division COMM class may count towards the electives requirement.
