

# MINOR IN EARTH SCIENCES

---

All coursework used to satisfy the requirements of the minor must be completed with a minimum grade point average of 2.0.

The Minor in Earth Sciences program consists of 15 units, including EARTH 400, EARTH 500 and 9 units of Earth Sciences electives selected with the advice and approval of a Department of Earth & Climate Sciences faculty advisor. (See program requirements below.)

## Earth Sciences Minor – 15 units

### Required Courses (6 units)

ERTH 400	Earth Systems I	3
ERTH 500	Earth Systems II	3

### Electives (9 units)

1. Complete at least 9 units of selected Earth & Climate Sciences (ERTH) (or closely related) coursework in consultation with a Department of Earth & Climate Sciences faculty advisor.
2. At least 6 of the 9 units must come from courses with the EARTH prefix.
3. At least 6 of the 9 units must be upper division coursework.
4. No more than 3 of the 9 units can come from a course designed primarily for General Education (such as 300-level EARTH courses).
