

BACHELOR OF ARTS IN LATINA/LATINO STUDIES – LTNS ASSOCIATE DEGREE FOR TRANSFER (ADT) ROADMAP

This is a sample pathway for students who transfer to San Francisco State University in the current Bulletin year with an AA-T in Chicana/o Studies, Latina/o Studies. Six units in the major (LTNS 215 and LTNS 278) and all lower-division GE requirements have been satisfied. Check with a major advisor about the most appropriate course sequence for you. **Degree completion guaranteed in 60 units; see the Associate Degree for Transfer (ADT) section for more information (<https://bulletin.sfsu.edu/undergraduate-admissions/transfer-students/>).**

To Do at SF State:

Enough total units to reach 120 minimum for graduation; 30 units minimum at the upper-division level; to include the following:

University-Wide Requirements: 15 Units

- American Institutions (0-6): US History, US Government, CA State and Local Government requirements. If not completed before transfer, some major requirement courses also satisfy specific major requirements.
- University Graduation Writing Assessment Requirement/GWAR (3 units): ETHS 300GW
- Upper-Division GE (9 units): Courses required for the major may double-count if approved for UD GE.
- Students entering the major with the AA-T in Chicana/o Studies, Latina/o Studies are not required to fulfill SF State Studies requirements.

Latina/Latino Studies Major: 27 Units

- Core (9 units)
- GWAR: ETHS 300GW
- Electives (15 units)

University Electives: 15 or More Units

Depends on course choices made at the community college, how transferred units are applied to the requirements above, and course choices at SF State. Some courses may meet more than one requirement, e.g. in both UD GE and in the major.
