

BACHELOR OF ARTS IN MUSIC – MUS ASSOCIATE DEGREE FOR TRANSFER (ADT) ROADMAP

This is a sample pathway for students who transfer to San Francisco State University in the current Bulletin year with an AA-T in Music. At least 13 units in the major (MUS 221, MUS 222, MUS 231, MUS 232, MUS 233, possibly MUS 201, MUS 202) and all lower-division GE requirements have been satisfied. Check with a major advisor about the most appropriate course sequence. **Degree completion guaranteed in 60 units**; see the Associate Degree for Transfer (ADT) section for more information (<http://bulletin.sfsu.edu/undergraduate-admissions/transfer-students/>).

To Do at SF State:

Enough total units to reach 120 minimum for graduation; 30 units minimum at the upper-division level; to include the following:

University-Wide Requirements: 9-15 units

- American Institutions (6 units): US History, US Government, California State and Local Government requirements if not taken before transfer.
- Upper-Division GE, Areas B, C, and D (9 units).
- Students entering this major with the AA-T in Music are not required to fulfill SF State Studies requirements.
- Complementary Studies: Consult with a department advisor on how transfer units and SF State units can be applied to ensure degree completion within 60 units.

Music (B.A.) Major: 30-32 units

(MUS 221, MUS 222, MUS 231, MUS 232, and MUS 233 completed in ADT; class piano may have been completed in ADT) depending on the number of requirements met via ADT.

- Lower-Division Core (0-2 units): MUS 201 and either MUS 202 or MUS 206, if not taken for ADT.
- Upper-Division Core/GWAR (11 units).
- Electives (19 units) – Chosen from MUS courses numbered above 299 - select in consultation with a Music faculty advisor.
- Auditions required for private study and performance ensembles.
- Concert attendance required each semester in residence: MUS 150: Concert Music (0 units).

University Electives: 11 or more units

Depends on course choices made at the community college, how transferred units are applied to the requirements above, and course choices at SF State - some courses may meet more than one requirement, e.g., JD GE and the major.

 Select 6 units from MUS 501 - MUS 559, excluding MUS 542GW
- Instruction and Ensembles*
 Select 6 units from MUS 371 - MUS 390. Students may fulfill a maximum of 2 of these 6 units from MUS 303, MUS 313, or MUS 353. Please note that private instruction and performance ensembles require audition.
- ² **Upper-Division Electives (6-9 units)**
 Select 6-9 units of coursework numbered above MUS 299 in consultation with a Music faculty advisor.
